Parish Council News

GRASSMOOR CCTV SCHEME TO GO AHEAD

The Parish Council has been successful in obtaining all the necessary funding to introduce CCTV in the village. The scheme will cost over £60,000 which has been funded in part by grants from the Derbyshire Community Safety Partnership, North East Derbyshire District Council, Grassmoor Primary School and Surestart. Grassmoor Methodist Church, Grassmoor Post Office and the Boot and Shoe also kindly contributed the costs of the scheme. The Parish Council contribution is likely to be in the region of £22,000. The on-going maintenance and replacement cost s will also be met by the Parish Council.

Tenders for the work are currently being sought. It is hoped that the cameras will be in operation by February. As part of the scheme, streetlighting on those parts of North Wingfield Road covered by the cameras will be improved. The Parish Council are also hoping to improve the streetlighting on Mill Lane as part of the project.



Councillor Betty Hill, Chairman of the Parish Council expressed her delight that the scheme was to go ahead. "Grassmoor has suffered a great deal of nuisance and anti-social behaviour over the last year and something had to be done. The Dispersal Order has helped to solve the problems in the short-term and hopefully the CCTV will provide a more lasting solution"

Grassmoor to get Police Beat Officer
