Parish Council News

GRASSMOOR CCTV SCHEME

As reported in the September Newsletter, the Parish Council has been successful in obtaining all the necessary funding to introduce CCTV in the village. In addition to Parish Council funding, contributions towards the costs of the Scheme have been received from Derbyshire County Council, North East Derbyshire District Council, SureStart, the Boot and Shoe and Grassmoor Post Office. UiT CCTV Ltd have been awarded the contract for the provision of the system and hopefully the cameras should be operational by mid December. Once the cameras are up and running, testing will take place to ensure that the best and maximum coverage has been achieved. Street lighting on North Wingfield Road and hopefully Mill Lane will be improved.

The Scheme will cover the length of North Wingfield Road from the junction with New Street to the Boot and Shoe. Mill Lane, the Community Centre, the Methodist Church, the School, the play equipment and youth shelter in Barnes Park and the walkway to Tennyson Way will also be covered.

The Parish Council hope that the introduction of the cameras will help address the crime and anti-social behaviour that has occurred in Grassmoor over the last year or so.
