Parish Council News

GRASSMOOR CCTV SCHEME

The CCTV system is now fully up and running. The Parish Council has adopted a CCTV Policy which sets out how the scheme should be operated and also details safeguards to prevent the use of the cameras being abused. Anyone wishing to look at the Policy can do so by looking at the CCTV pages on the website—www.grassmoor.org.uk. Alternatively you can contact the Parish Clerk to obtain a copy. The Parish Council is also looking to purchase an additional “mobile” camera that can be erected at any “hotspots” of anti-social behaviour or criminal activity that occur on a regular basis outside the range of the permanent cameras.

BARNES PARK REFURBISHMENT

The Parish Council is hoping to develop plans to refurbish Barnes Park. The plans, which will be dependent on grant funding being received, will include a new sports pavilion, new pathways, a disabled entrance and new fencing around the boundary. As part of the development of the plans, a consultation exercise will be carried out with all households and local sports clubs to help the Council decide on the priorities for

Illegal Motor Cycling

The Parish Council has received several complaints about motor cycles using local roads and the Country Park illegally. The bikes are being ridden in a dangerous manner by under age riders with no licence or insurance. The Parish Council is concerned that if this problem is not stopped an accident will occur which will result in serious injury or worse. The Police have powers to take action including the confiscation of the motorbikes. In order to assist the Police it is important that the problems are reported to the Police immediately in order that they can catch those responsible. Streetlighting

The new improved streetlighting on North Wingfield Road has now been installed. The Parish Council has also placed an order to improve lighting on Mill Lane, although no date has yet been set for the works to be undertaken. An additional street light at the junction of Birkin Lane and Smithy Place has also been ordered.

The Parish Council has agreed to reinstate the seat at the end of Churchside Lane.
